


Floor Solutions

RCR architects, awarded with the prestigious Pritzker Architecture Prize, have designed a unique building. This building is fully integrated into the environment and is a pioneer project in Europe in terms of sustainability.


These new facilities occupy an area of 18.200 m² and have a production capacity that will exceed two million bottles of wine per year, being the first wine cellar built with the LEED® BD + C certification in Europe.

A high performance system

Castillo Peralada was looking for high-performance floor systems suitable for each specific area and besides this, aesthetics was of great importance. For this reason Stonhard suggested to coat all the supports and benches of the tanks with the same system. This ensured a clean look.

We offered a differentiated solution for each environment where maximum durability was required.

In the bottling and storage area we installed our high resistance Stonclad UR/Stonkote HT4 system on both walls and floors. Stonshield SLT was the flooring solution for other areas including; the harvest area, the cellar, barrel storage, geothermal energy room, the laboratory, and the pressing area.
